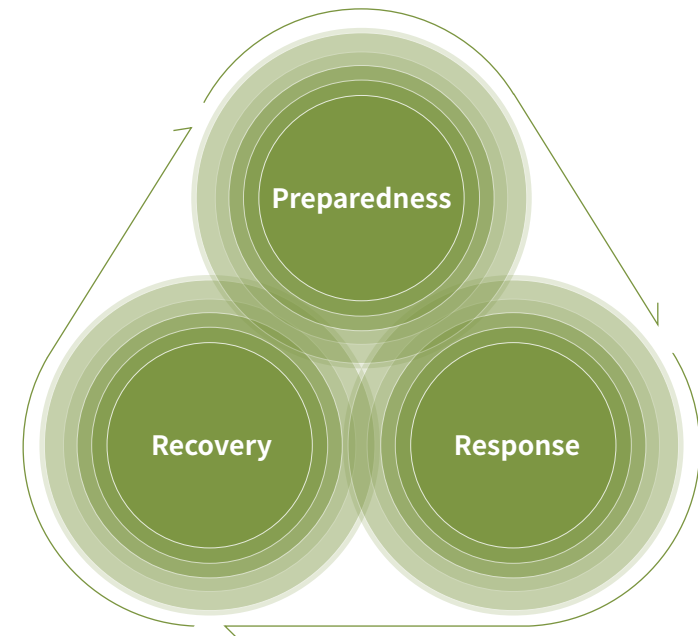

GOOD NEIGHBORS COVID-19 RESPONSE FRAMEWORK

Preparedness

- Developing methods for effective intra-community communication and early-warning
- Enhancing people's and communities' awareness on COVID-19 and its prevention



Recovery

- Supporting rapid recovery of livelihoods for people affected by COVID-19
- Seeking for innovative opportunities for growth and development in a post-pandemic situation

Response

- Monitoring COVID-19 situations in affected communities
- Responding to urgent needs of people in health, food and livelihood
- Strengthening community resilience through participative COVID-19 responses

Health / WASH



- Monitoring of COVID-19 case incidence in communities
- Campaigns and training on safe water treatment and storage
- Establishment and renovation of handwashing facilities
- Provision of COVID-19 testing kits

Bangladesh: Community-Led Health Action

Good Neighbors Bangladesh launches “Telemedicine Service” to provide immediate treatment in target communities by registered doctors and health officers. GN Bangladesh operates “Mobile Handwashing Booths” in remote villages leading behavioral change toward appropriate hygiene practice while providing hand washing facilities and distributing masks.



Food Security



- Distribution of food supply kits and micronutrient supplements

Zambia: Food Distribution

Good Neighbors Zambia provides food packages to vulnerable households in rural communities to support their livelihood, prevent malnourishment and under-nutrition and avoid negative coping mechanisms. During food distribution, Good Neighbors staff raise awareness on safety precautions and provide information on hygiene measures.



Child Protection



- Child right campaigns to prevent child abuse, violence, and exploitation at home
- Psycho-Social Support (PSS) for children in need
- Provision of child right education and campaigns

Philippines: Psycho-Social Support (PSS) for Children

Good Neighbors Philippines empowers the mental and physical resilience and well-being of children during the pandemic through one-on-one Psycho-Social Support (PSS) sessions. Children remotely participate at the session from home and are given the opportunity to express their feelings during this distressing situation and learn positive coping methods while minimizing the impact of traumatic experiences.



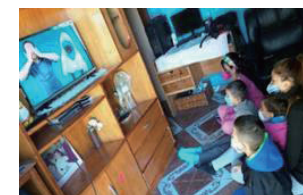
Education

‘Good Kids’ is educational broadcasting content produced through the close collaboration between Good Neighbors Paraguay and the Ministry of Education and Science of Paraguay. The alternative education media content is broadcast by the Paraguay national television and improves accessibility to education of children at home.

Myanmar & Madagascar: COVID-19 Testing Kit Support

Good Neighbors Myanmar in collaboration with United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) in Myanmar supports testing kits to public health facilities and emergency health centers to facilitate the accurate monitoring of COVID-19 situation and strengthen the response capacity of health authorities.

Good Neighbors Madagascar in collaboration with the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in Madagascar provides testing kits to health institutions in Madagascar. Besides, Good Neighbors supports PPEs, surgical masks, and other medical supplies to strengthen a comprehensive national COVID-19 response capacity.
